## **USSA TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION FEES FOR 2011**

The Council of USSA (2 October 2010) approved the following tournament fees payable to Organising Committees of USSA tournaments/events for 2011:

**1. Accommodation: R315 per person per day (VAT included)**

The accommodation tariff includes three meals per day, bedding and value-added tax. Where bedding is not supplied, the accommodation cost should be reduced to R280 per person per day. Host institutions should further provide for the food preferences of all cultural and religious groups. Participating institutions or provinces must pay for the accommodation of their teams for the full duration of a tournament (USSA Regulations, Article 3.10.1).

**2. Caution fee: R35 per person (VAT not applicable)**

Caution fees are paid to host institutions to cover for breakages and/or damage to the property of the host. Caution fees must be reimbursed in full if no damage has been done. If damage has occurred, but the person(s) or institution/province cannot be identified, then a pro-rata amount shall be deducted from all institutions/provinces that participated at the tournament (USSA Regulations, Article 3.10.5).

**3. Final dinner fee: R130 per person (VAT included)**

Entertainment and final function expenses must be kept to a minimum and within the budget. The format of the final prize-giving dinner may differ from sport to sport, but it should be equivalent to a three-course meal, i.e. starter, main dish and desert (USSA Regulations, Article 3.10.4).

**4. Travel expenses**

Participating individuals, through their institutions and/or provinces shall be responsible for their own cost of travel to and from tournaments (USSA Regulations, Article 3.10.2). Institutions/provinces are also responsible for their own local transport costs. Where possible, institutions from the same region should endeavour to share transport and costs.

**5. Tournament levies**

National University Sports Associations and Organising Committees of USSA tournaments should note that well-motivated applications to levy additional costs in terms of Article 3.19.3 of the USSA Regulations, must be submitted to the NEC of USSA for consideration at least forty-five (45) days before the tournament is due to start.
